You are Fortifying our Communities of Faith

In the summer of 2013 the pastor of St. Mary Parish in White Swan, Fr. Bill Shaw, made a request to the Catholic Foundation to assist with their parish religious education program. Fr. Shaw assessed ordinary income for the parish that year at \$89,500. The application read as follows -

"St. Mary's Catholic Church is located on the Yakima Indian reservation in the community of White Swan. White Swan

is an unincorporated community with no local government or law enforcement. The only real community resources are the churches and the school. The community is faced with poverty, child abuse/neglect, drug and alcohol abuse, suicides and a sense of hopelessness. With the potential support from the Celebration of Faith Fund, our parish will be able to broaden our efforts in bringing a quality religious education program for our parish members and ultimately impacting the families of the greater community of White Swan. support that you can provide in this effort will be greatly appreciated." - Fr. Bill Shaw

Since that time, St. Mary Parish has received between \$3,900 and \$5,000 annually and the program has seen tremendous growth. The Sacramental classes have grown from 3 to 25 and additional classes have been added, with more than one class being held in the rectory.

Parent Perlita Rodriguez says that, "The religious education classes here at St.

Mary's have benefited the community and all the families around. A lot of the kids are eager to come to class and everybody keeps on coming back. The classes are growing and getting bigger. The kids are loving it!"
