# An Invitation To Faith

"My name is Amy Krautscheid and I am the Principal of St. Rose School in Eprhrata, but more importantly, I am the mother of 5 children.

The journey I have been on has been on has almost entirely been through the invitation of Christ.

It was an invitation at the age of 18 at WSU of one person that invited me to a Search Retreat that led me to Jesus. I fell in love with him and have followed him ever since.

I went on to become a public school teacher. After praying on an invitation; my husband and I put our oldest daughter at St. Rose of Lima School in Ephrata and fell in love with

Catholic education. A few years later, I received the invitation to my calling, - "Will you come and help out St. Rose School and be our principal."

If you don't have a catholic school in your area you might not know that our kids talk about the saints during reading, writing and math. They talk about Jesus and Catholic scientific discoveries. It is all day long. In fact it is a total of 1,260 hours of faith learning each year.

In Ephrata, our students mainstream into the public school and CCD classes after the sixth grade. CCD classes are a priceless gift that we have in our churches that we need to protect. My older two children attend a beautiful, faith inspired program at St. Pius X in Quincy, but they only get 27 hours of faith education a year. My 13 and 15 year olds realize they are not alone in their school because they have these amazing religious educators teaching them that the saints are surrounding them. They know that Jesus is carrying them, so they can get through the challenges of being teenagers, but it is a heavy load for a parents to make up for 1,000 lost hours of faith education.

The St. Rose CCD program is bursting at the seams and yet I have empty seats in my school, so we are missing the boat. There are people waiting for that invitation. As a principal and a mother, I want to educate these students with the Lord as their guide. I want to form their moral compass with Jesus, not with the world.

Each year, at St. Rose, I give out close to \$60,000 in scholarships and I always fall short. The Celebration of Faith has allowed me to open the doors wider at St. Rose School. It has allowed me to extend that invitation to more families and share this blessing of Catholic education. Our school is more diverse now and our budget is really eased from the

huge burden of need. Families are just now beginning to say maybe. It is because of this funding that they are beginning to see that a Catholic education is attainable.

The world is loud. Our kids are receiving messages about what is important from the internet, social media, other religious groups, and clubs at school. I want to see these students, rich or poor, go out into our world and lead with Jesus and I need your help to do it."
