The Board of Trustees decided that funds raised at the Celebration of Faith in October 2013 would first be used to renew the tuition assistance grant of any returning and qualified student. Recently we renewed 46 of the 50 grants for students for next year. We are now reviewing applications for students who will be new to our Catholic schools in the Fall of 2014. We have awarded half of the allocated funds for new students already and we are only a couple months into the application period. Can you help us to significantly increase the Celebration of Faith Fund so that we can award grants to all of the qualified new student applicants?

Fundraising for us is a year-around effort and we are asking for your generosity throughout the year so that we may continue the mission. This is an update of thanks and an appeal to continue supporting the mission of the Central Washington Catholic Foundation: to support Catholic education.

In addition to tuition assistance grants for students in our Catholic schools we are supporting religious education in our needy parishes and this has been very successful as well. This year we hope to award \$40,000 to assist parishes with curriculum, materials, equipment, stipends, and catechist education. Last year over \$27,000 was awarded to a dozen parishes in need of financial assistance.

The Board of Trustees and Bishop Tyson believe that any child who wants to learn about Jesus should have that opportunity regardless of the financial resources of their family or parish. Our annual event will be held on October 11th, 2014 at the Yakima Convention Center. Will you consider a donation now so we can help more children learn about Jesus?
