Board of Trustees Select new Executive Director; Dan Fortier Brings Wealth of Experience

YAKIMA, WA – After an intensive national search, Central Washington Catholic Foundation (CWCF) is pleased to announce the appointment of Daniel C. Fortier as its new director. Fortier most recently was a registered representative and agent at New York Life and has been associated with CWCF in a variety of capacities from the foundation's inception, including being one of the four individuals credited for its creation in 2002.

Fortier has held the CWCF offices of President of the Board of Trustees (current), Vice-President, and Immediate Past President. With almost 40 years of financial service experience, Fortier has served on many local civic and financial community boards and leadership councils. He holds a bachelor of arts degree in business administration from Central Washington University and a master's degree in financial services from American College.

In his new role as foundation director, Fortier will be responsible for providing oversight, planning, leadership, cultivating community partnerships, and continued development of foundation initiatives

pertaining to Catholic organizations such as schools, parishes, and agencies in Central Washington. CWCF regional network consists of Chelan, Douglas, Yakima, Kittitas, Grant, Benton, and Klickitat Counties. Fortier will begin his new position March 1st.

Fortier is taking the reins from Rev. Samuel P. Bellino, S.J., founding director since 2002, after he announced last year his intentions to leave his post and return to his province in the San Francisco Bay area. Bellino is a member of the Yakima Downtown Rotary and volunteers as a vice president for the Executive Board of the Grand Columbia Council of the Boys Scouts of America.

As one of the four founding members of CWCF, Bellino has helped the foundation raise over \$5.5 million dollars since its inception in the fall of 2002. In addition, during his tenure, Bellino is credited with helping create the Francis Eugene Cardinal George Medallion Award. Given out once every three years, it encourages public recognition of members of the Catholic Community in Central Washington



whose lives and accomplishments reflect the mission and values of CWCF.

"It has been a great honor to have had the opportunity to serve Central Washington Catholics through the CWCF foundation," says Fr. Sam Bellino, former director of Central Washington Catholic Foundation. "I am confident that the appointment of Dan to director will further continue to build the foundation's philanthropic initiatives."

Consejo de Administración Escoge Nuevo Director Ejecutivo; Dan Fortier Se Enfoca Trae Riqueza de Experiencia

 YAKIMA, WA – Después de una intensiva búsqueda nacional, la Fundación Católica de Washington Central (CWCF) está contenta en anunciar el nombramiento de Daniel C. Fortier como su nuevo director. Fortier recientemente era un representante certificado y agente de New York Life y ha estado asociado con la CWCF en una variedad de capacidades desde el

inicio de la fundación, incluso siendo uno de los cuatro individuos acreditados con su creación en 2002.

Fortier ha ocupado los puestos en la CWCF de presidente del Consejo de Administración (actualmente), Vicepresidente, y Presidente Inmediato Pasado. Con casi 40 años de experiencia en servicio financiero, Fortier ha servido en muchos consejos cívicos locales y consejos comunitarios financieros y consejos de liderazgo. Él sostiene un título de licenciado en artes en administración de empresa de Central Washington University y un título de licenciado en servicios financieros de American College.

En su nuevo papel como director de la fundación, Fortier será responsable de proporcionar el cuidado, la planificación, el mando, cultivando sociedades de comunidad, y continuo desarrollo de iniciativas de la

fundación que pertenecen a organizaciones católicas, como escuelas, parroquias, y agencias en Washington Central. La red regional de la CWCF consiste en los condados de Chelan, Douglas, Yakima, Kittitas, Grant, Benton, y Klickitat. Fortier comenzará su nueva posición el 1 de marzo.

Fortier está tomando las riendas del Rev. Samuel P. Bellino, S.J., el director fundador desde 2002, después de que él anunció el año pasado sus intenciones de dejar su puesto y volver a su provincia en el área de la Bahía de San Francisco. Bellino es un miembro de Yakima Downtown Rotary y se ofrece como vicepresidente para la Mesa Ejecutiva del Consejo de Grand Colombia de los Boys Scouts de América.

Como uno de los cuatro miembros fundadores de la CWCF, Bellino ha

ayudado a la fundación a recaudar más de 5.5 millones de dólares desde su inicio en el otoño de 2002. Además, durante su cargo, Bellino es acreditado con ayudar a crear el Premio Medallón de Cardenal Francis Eugene George. Otorgado una vez cada tres años, este anima el reconocimiento público de miembros de la comunidad católica en Washington Central cuyas vidas y logros reflejan la misión y valores de la CWCF.






