



and the **Seminarian Education Fund** received \$23,426.22 each.

In his 33 years of priestly service, Father Wuertz was pastor of four parishes in the Diocese of Yakima. He was pastor of Saint Joseph Parish in Kennewick, Saint Andrew's Parish in Ellensburg, Christ the King Parish in Richland, and Saint Francis de Sales Parish in Chelan. Please see the box below for the dates and locations of his ministry.

Ordained a priest for the *Diocese of Yakima* in 1968, he graduated from Yakima Senior High School in 1957, now Davis High School. Fr.

Wuertz graduated from Carroll College in Helena, Montana in 1963 and continued in graduate school in theology at Saint Thomas Seminary in Kenmore, WA.

During his priesthood he held a number of positions including Bishop's Consultor to Bishops Skylstad, George and Sevilla. He was a member and once chair of the Priests' Personnel Board and the Diocesan Priests' Council. He worked on the Diocesan Finance Board and the Diocesan Marriage Tribunal. At the Tribunal, he served as advocate, judge and defender of the bond of marriage. He also served on the National Federation of Priests Board.

The only child of Robert and Olive (Suverly) Wuertz, his family had been the people of the parishes he served and his brother priests.



Death Does Not Deter Priest's Loving Gift

Even in death a beloved priest gave to his Catholic Community in Central Washington. Rev. Richard A. Wuertz died of heart disease on May 30, 2001, while pastor of Saint Francis de Sales Parish in Chelan, WA.

In his *Last Will and Testament*, he gave the *Central Washington Catholic Foundation* the "residue and remainder of the cash assets" of his estate after payment of all bills and bequests. His gift to CWCF totaled \$58,565.54.

He gave to three CWCF funds that benefited Saint Joseph in Kennewick, Christ the King in Richland and Seminarian education. **Saint Joseph Kennewick Education Fund** received \$11,713.11. Both the **Rev. Msgr. William J. Sweeney Educational Fund** for Christ the King Parish School
