# Mom's Bequest Aids CWCF

## Mrs. Howell Gives \$10,000



A final wish was granted when, through a trust, Marie A. Howell's estate donated \$10,000 to the *Central Washington Catholic Foundation*.

"We are grateful to Mrs. Howell and her family for such a wonderful gift" said Rev. Samuel P. Bellino, S.J., Executive Director of the CWCF. "It says so much about her commitment to Catholic values."

Marie was born in 1917 to Adam J. and Petronilla K. (Karl) Eifler in Brooklyn, N.Y. She was the ninth of ten children and grew up in New York. At one time, she worked for Bloomingdales.

She met her future husband James R. (Bob) Howell, on a blind double date while in the Navy Medical Corps during WWII. They were married in Wier, Kansas after the war. They moved with their family to the Tri-Cities in 1956. The couple had four children: Gregory, Robert, Anita, and Marie.

According to her daughter Anita M. Braun of Richland, her mother was known for working behind the scene in her parish of 43 years.

"My mom was a member of the Altar Society" said Anita. "She had a strong devotion to Our Blessed Mother." Marie was most remembered for decades running the Sunday Church Nursery at St. Joseph Church in Kennewick.

"I remember helping my mother with my sister for the *longest* time." said Anita, who has continued the family tradition of service by being a teacher's aid at Christ the King School in Richland for the past 13 years. She added, "It was a lot of fun!"

Marie's husband, Bob, died of cancer in 1993. She went home to God on July 21, 2004.

"She was a great mom" said daughter Anita.

## Large Number Of Nominees Entered For Cardinal George Medallion Award

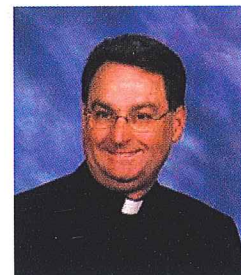
Many thanks to all the members of the Catholic community in Central Washington who nominated someone for the first **Francis Eugene Cardinal George Medallion** award.
