Evidence for God—Keynote by Fr. Robert Spitzer

Why is Catholic education necessary? Why do we need it? Our kids today really face a crisis that we didn't have to face. Forty-four percent of our kids will lose their faith. I am not saying they are going to drop out of the Catholic Church they will certainly do that - forty-four percent will lose their faith in God. That is what is going to happen and the percentage increase is going to get higher and [Catholic schools and faith formation programs] are the only way to stop it.

We have got to pound it home because the culture is going to pound it home as hard as they can that God is nonsensical, that the soul really doesn't exist, that you are just a bunch of atoms and molecules, and that Jesus Christ is not even

real, let alone risen from the dead. The reason we need Catholic [education] is to refute the myths.

We've got a challenge here. The last two days we have been equipping people as fast as we can thanks to your generosity to put these 7 Essential Modules into the [schools and faith formation programs] in any way we can and bring this message not only to the kids but to the [faith formators] and ultimately the parents.

Let me just give a few of the myths. The first myth is that faith and science are contradictory. The first thing the kids are told is that most scientists are atheists. That is not true. The latest poll shows conclusively that 51% of working bench scientists are theists and that 77% of physicians are believers in God.

Another big myth—the soul doesn't exist. The soul is just a figment of the religious imagination gone awry. You are just a bunch of atoms and molecules. There is enough veridical data, that is to say verifiable data by independent researchers, to show that you have a transphysical soul. Kids deserve to know.

A lot of the myths are on Jesus, that He is a figment of New Testament imagination. We have terrific historical evidence for Jesus' existence and his crucifixion. The Shroud of Turin is the most unique relic that we have. The crucifixion evidence is fantastic, but what the kids need to know more than anything is the resurrection evidence. There is only one energy source we know of in physics that can produce the image on the Shroud and that is light. Dead bodies do not normally produce 6-8 billion watts of light energy, emanating from every three dimensional point in that body. That is the evidence of Jesus's resurrection in glory and spirit. Our kids deserve to know it.
